STRESS...The Silent Killer

Parents, be aware that your children experience stress, just as adults do. What we have shared here would apply to them, too.

If you are stressed, you might feel:

- \Rightarrow Irritable, angry, impatient or wound up.
- Over-burdened or overwhelmed.
- Anxious, nervous or afraid. \Rightarrow
- As if your thoughts are racing and you can't switch off. \Rightarrow
- Unable to enjoy yourself. \Rightarrow
- Depressed.

- Uninterested in life.
- As if you've lost your sense of humour.

These tips may help you keep stress at bay:

- Keep a positive attitude. \Rightarrow
- Accept that there are events that you cannot control.
- Be assertive instead of aggressive.
- \Rightarrow Assert your feelings, opinions or beliefs instead of becoming angry, defensive or passive.
- Learn to manage your time more effectively.
- Set limits appropriately and say no to requests that would create \Rightarrow excessive stress in your life.
- Make time for hobbies and interests. \Rightarrow
- \Rightarrow Don't rely on alcohol, drugs or compulsive behaviours to reduce stress. Drugs and alcohol can stress your body even more.
- Seek out social support. Spend enough time with those you love.
- Seek treatment with a psychologist or mental health professionals \Rightarrow trained in stress management and techniques to learn more healthy ways of dealing with the stress in your life.

What foods make stress worse? If you're feeling stressed, try to avoid these foods/beverages:

- Alcohol. \Rightarrow
- Caffeine.



- Sugary drinks and foods. \Rightarrow
- Processed foods, such as chips, biscuits, frozen foods and ready-made meals.
- Foods high in trans fats and excessive saturated fats, such as \rightarrow fried foods, red meat, full-fat dairy, butter and baked goods.

Here are 5 quick stress relievers:

- Count to 10 before you speak or react.
- Take a few slow, deep breaths until you feel your body unclench a bit.
- Go for a walk, even if it's just to the bathroom and back.
- Try a quick meditation or prayer to get some perspective.
- \Rightarrow If it's not urgent, sleep on it and respond tomorrow.

Edenvale High School has two trained and experienced Social Workers on the premises, who counsel learners every school day. They are currently being assisted by a full-time volunteer Counsellor. Children who experience unmanageable stress or exam anxiety are encouraged to arrange an appointment with Mrs K Hartel (in G1-2), or Ms M Mashalane (in F9). Learners may self-refer or parents may contact Mrs Hartel, Head of the Counselling Department directly.

Via a counselling process, children are able to learn emotional regulation and other healthy coping skills. Sessions are private and confidential but if Mrs Hartel, Ms Mashalane or Mr Coombe (volunteer Counsellor) become concerned about anything, they will, of course, contact parents.




