ARRANGEMENTS FOR 2024

Wednesday 17 January: pupils to be at school 07h45. Register class lists will be posted onto the communicator on 16 January, to indicate your child's register class and venue.

- Times for 2024:
 - In Term 1, school will close at 14h00 on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, and at 13h20 on Thursday.
- The Mathematics / Mathematical Literacy test for Grades 10 12 and Afrikaans test for Grades 8 and 9 will be written on 22 January 2024. This is compulsory for all learners. Those who are absent must produce a doctor's note, otherwise they will receive zero.
- Block-testing period will be from 21 February 1 March.
- All learners will write a Mathematics / Mathematical Literacy assessment on 20 March 2024. This is compulsory for all learners. Learners who are absent must produce a doctor's note; otherwise they will receive zero.
- Please take note that it is the school's practice to schedule a Formal Assessment Task on the last day of
 every term. Please do not make arrangements for an early departure for your holiday. This will not be
 accepted as a valid reason to miss the assessment and your child will be awarded zero, thus compromising
 his/her School-Based Assessment mark.
- All parents need to download the d6 communicator. This is the school's means of contact for all
 information. Note that the office will not print exam timetables and absentee note templates for
 learners.
- If you need to correct any information pertaining to change of address, contact number or email address,
 please send this information to Mrs Enell: jenell@edenvalehigh.co.za. The school works from one main
 central database; so any updates done to details linked to your d6 do not carry through to SMART. The
 school must be contacted directly.
- Parents may not drop off lunch, projects or items left at home at the front office. The admin staff are
 unable to collect and distribute these to learners, who must take responsibility for any items left at
 home.
- If a learner is feeling ill, he/she must see the Senior Tutor of the Grade before contacting his/her parents a detention will be given if this process is not followed.
- No learner is allowed to have a cell phone in his/her possession during school hours. If seen, the
 phone will be removed and will have to be collected by a parent.

CHANGES TO DISCIPLINE RULES:

- Note that learners caught with a vape in their possession will receive 15 demerits. A vape test will be conducted and if positive, they will receive 20 demerits and a two-day suspension in place of the 15 demerits. Those associated with a learner caught with a vape will have a vape test and, if the test is positive, will receive 20 demerits and a two-day suspension. Learners caught smoking the vape will receive 20 demerits and a two-day suspension. In both cases, the vape will be confiscated for three months and may only be collected by a parent.
- Learners with uniform defaults will be given a break detention. Failure to attend a break detention will
 result in a one-hour detention.
- Learners who do not attend a one-hour detention will receive 15 demerits and will attend one hour community service on a Friday afternoon. Learners who do not attend detention due to being absent from school will also attend a one-hour community service on a Friday afternoon.

LEARNERS WHO RECEIVED DEMERITS FOR UNIFORM DEFAULTS:

Learners who received demerits for uniform defaults during the exam period will have a detention on Friday 19 January from 14h00 – 15h00.

Should a learner have amassed more than 15 demerits for uniform defaults, he/she will have another detention on 26 January from 14h00 –15h00, in addition to the detention on 19 January.
